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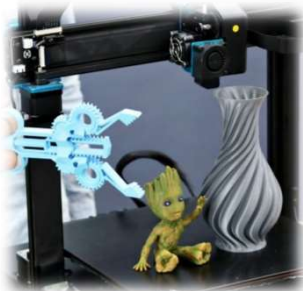

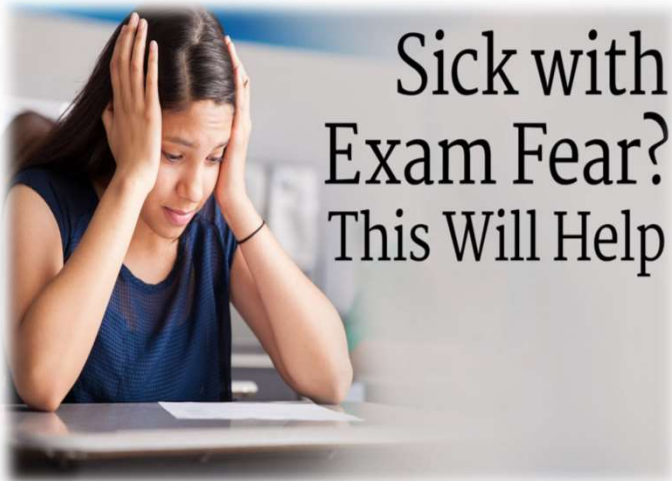

Just come along with a open mind and a positive attitude, and have some fun!



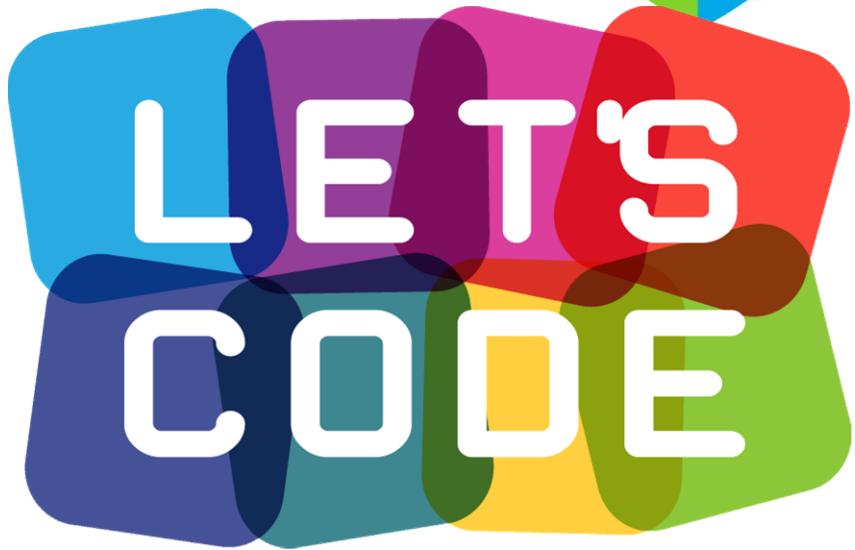

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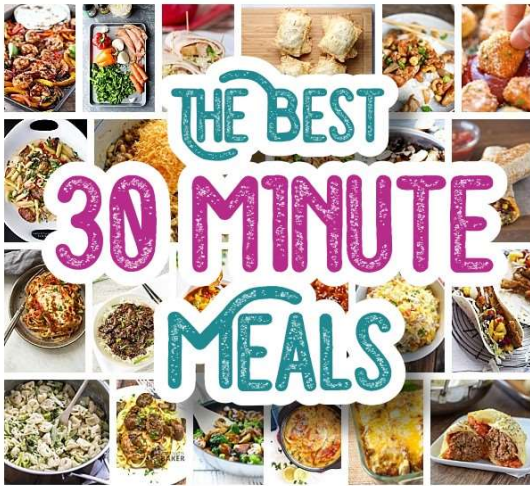
Young Carers Cooking Club

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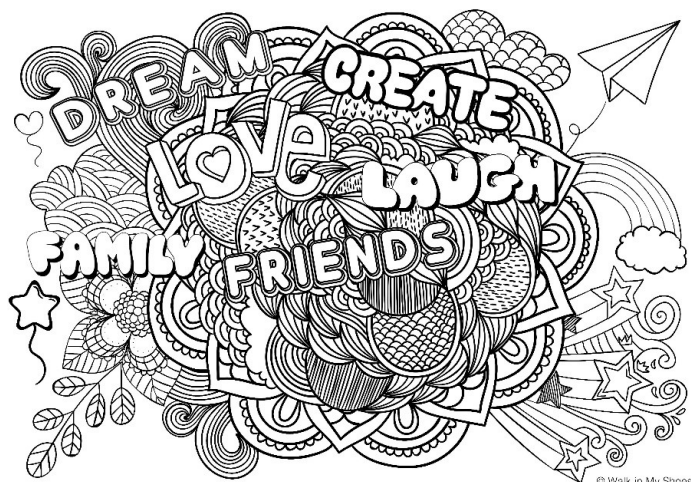
